

What is **RCM I**?

Rehoboth Camp Ministry for Independent Persons with Disabilities or RCM I is an extension of the camp program offered by Rehoboth Christian Ministries. **RCM I** is a Christian camp intended to serve disabled individual between the age of 18 - 40 who are able to do more on their own. It is designed for individuals who are also looking for less supervision while enjoying the camp experience. There will be the regular camp staff of two Directors, two Nurses, camp Pastor but the Camper—Counsellor ratio has changed to one Counsellor for every 4 — 5 Campers. **RCM I** offers campers more choices.

RCM I will require 30 volunteers, ranging from Camp Directors, Music Leader, Pastor, Nurses, Cooks, Counsellors and Night-watch Person. With volunteers this Ministry can continue to offer this camp at a reasonable cost to the campers attending.

Camp Objectives:

- To provide a week of Christian fellowship, growth and sharing for persons with disabilities and Volunteers, Counsellors and Staff.
- To provide an environment in which persons with disabilities interact socially with each other and Counsellors.
- Small group interaction with peers.
- To make friends and enjoy themselves.
- An affordable fun week for independent persons with disabilities.

What happens at **RCM I**?

RCM I will be an action packed week of fun activities with lots of free time to sit by the camp fire relaxing with old and new friends. Campers & Counsellors will be bunked in cabins and meals will be served to them by the volunteer cooks in the mess hall.

Three feature days:

- Sylvan Water Park
- Golfing in Lacombe
- Trail riding at the Ranch (Horse)

Individuals attending this camp need to meet the following requirements:

- Between the ages of 18 - 40
- Function with minimal supervision
- Follow instruction
- Sleep in a dorm environment
- Look after own belongings
- Be independent at personal hygiene
- Communicate and interact well with others
